- On Friday, February 14, York County OEM forwarded an email from the York County Planning Commission (YCPC) with an update on the status of the 72 York County Municipalities who have passed resolutions to adopt the 2024 York County Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP) which was finalized by YCPC last year. York City, 17 of the 35 Townships and 10 of the 36 Boroughs have adopted the HMP. Loganville's HMP adoption resolution is in process and is expected to be submitted to the YCPC by the end of the 1st quarter. After submission, the YCPC will forward Loganville's resolution to the Pennsylvania and Federal EM Agencies, which is the final step.
- Payment has been made for some of the Fine Letters (1st Offense) for three (3) residents who had vehicles parked on the street alongside their houses during the SED that was in effect for WS Demi in violation of Loganville Ordinance 2010-01, Parking During Declared Snow Emergencies, December 6, 2010 (with amendment).
- Seven (7) Warning Letters and four (4) Fine Letters (1st Offense) for WS Freya and two (2) Warning Letters and three (3) Fine Letters (1st Offense) for WSs Harlow and Iliana were issued during the month of February. Some of these fines have been paid.
