### DECLARATION OF SNOW EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the National Weather Service has issued a Winter Weather Advisory for south central Pennsylvania due to Winter Storm Garrett, with snowfall expected to begin around 6:00 pm today which threatens to cause injury, damage and suffering to the persons and property of Loganville Borough; and


**WHEREAS**, the storm may endanger the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Loganville Borough, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Loganville Borough may be able to resolve; and

**WHEREAS**, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents of Loganville Borough;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I the undersigned Mayor of Loganville Borough, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Service Code (35 Pa. C.S. §§ 7501) as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a snow emergency in Loganville Borough. As part of the emergency, pursuant to Loganville Borough Ordinance 2010-01, *Parking During Declared Snow Emergencies*, I now mandate that all motorized **vehicles and trailers of any type that are parked on borough streets** be removed so snow plowing can be done effectively and safely so the streets can be kept open for other emergencies that may occur, and I recommend that residents limit their travel to only emergency essential trips.

**FURTHER**, pursuant to Loganville Borough Ordinances 2010-01 and 2014-01, *Removing Snow and Ice from Sidewalks (and Fire Hydrants)*, residents are reminded that **warnings and/or fines may be applicable to violations of these ordinances**, which can be found on the borough webpage. Vehicles parked on streets may be towed at the owner's expense.

This Declaration shall take effect at 6 pm on Thursday, January 6, 2022, and remain in effect for 48 hours through 6 pm, Saturday, January 6, 2022.
